

Invitation to the 2024-25 Father Friendly Provider Network

Please join us, in-person, to launch the 2024-25 Father-Friendly Provider Network (FFPN) on September 20, 2024.

The Alameda County Fathers Corps, established in 2013, is a program of First 5 Alameda County. It began as a collaborative effort with Alameda County's Health Care Services Agency, Social Services Agency, Department of Probation, and Department of Child Support. The Fathers Corps was created to address a significant gap in services within early childhood, community service, and social and family support sectors, which traditionally focused on mothers and children, leaving fathers underserved and underrepresented. One of the Fathers Corps efforts to transform this dynamic is building the capacity of service providers to effectively engage and support fathers and father-figures through our learning communities.

The Father-Friendly Provider Network (FFPN) was established in 2018 to train providers interested in enhancing their ability to see, serve, and support fathers and father-figures. FFPN participants are committed to shifting how families are served by intentionally and strategically including fathers in their family engagement and support activities. The FFPN offers monthly trainings from September through May, focusing on expanding participants' knowledge of fathers' experiences, needs, and challenges.
